We offer you this course to help you develop on your journey to becoming an educator with responsibilities for design, delivery and leadership of a Simulation-based education (SBE) programme. Maybe you have an idea for SBE, or you have been approached by a colleague who wants you to use simulation to help solve a patient safety problem? This course will provide you with the knowledge, skills and attitudes to lead on the development, delivery, and management of a SBE programme. The course language is English, requiring an ability to take part in conversations.

Target Group You have at least 2 years of experience as a simulation educator in healthcare. You have

participated in the EuSim level 1 and 2 courses (or equivalent) and are comfortable delivering SBE as a faculty member. You recognize some exciting learning opportunities where SBE could increase patient safety and quality of care but need some training on developing and managing

these programmes.

Course Goals To provide you with, and allow you to practice using, the knowledge, skills, and attitudes

required to develop and lead a simulation-based training programme.

Course Content The role of the course developer/lead and skills required. What is, and how to do, a needs

analysis? How to write Course Aims and Objectives. Choosing the right course content and delivery methods. Practical aspects of course planning: staffing, equipment, rooms, budgets.

What to evaluate and how? How to develop and support your faculty.

Methods Mixed methodologies including lectures, theoretical inputs, exchange of experiences, small

group discussions, practical workshops, and structured reflections. After learning about each topic, you will put your new knowledge into practice and apply your learning immediately in a small group workshop leading to sequential development of a selected course over 3 days.

Cost The course fee is Euro 1600 Euros including lunch, soft drinks and coffee during the days, a

reception day 1 and dinner day 2. Travel and lodging are not included.
