Conducting a debriefing can be an overwhelming experience to simulation facilitators, as it depends on various factors. More than just conducting a structured debriefing and discuss the simulation scenario, you want to facilitate deep reflection on both individual and team levels, as this will create a vehicle to shape future performance and improve patient safety.

Debriefing strategies and questioning techniques can foster a constructive and safe dialogue, promote self-awareness, and catalyse performance improvement.

This **NEW EuSim course** aims to help you building-up your confidence as a skilled debriefer, by enhancing your strategies and tools. Through practical exercises you will refining your skills to collect “pearls”, enhance perception, and stimulate deeper reflections. All of this in a safe learning environment enriched with different perspectives and shared experiences.

In this **2-days practical course** you will be actively involved in debriefing facilitation exercises, revisit debriefing structure and questioning techniques, develop strategies to monitor debriefing to maintain its quality, and discover how active listening and curiosity can be powerful tools to explore frames.
